






The Sungurlu and İsaköy Regulators, Tunnel and Open Channel Construction is one of the 8 projects of Istanbul Water Supply Project Yeşilçay System. The aim of the project is to convey Sungurlu river water to the existing pumping station at İsaköy by the way of tunnel and transmission channel.

Within this project;

Sungurlu regulator $: 8 \text{ m}^3/\text{sec} = 700\ 000 \text{ m}^3 / \text{day},$ İsaköy regulator $: 12 \text{ m}^3/\text{sec} = 1\ 000\ 000 \text{ m}^3 / \text{day},$

3 848 m long lined trapeze channel and 312 m long, 3.50 m diameter tunnel was constructed.
